Pick #1

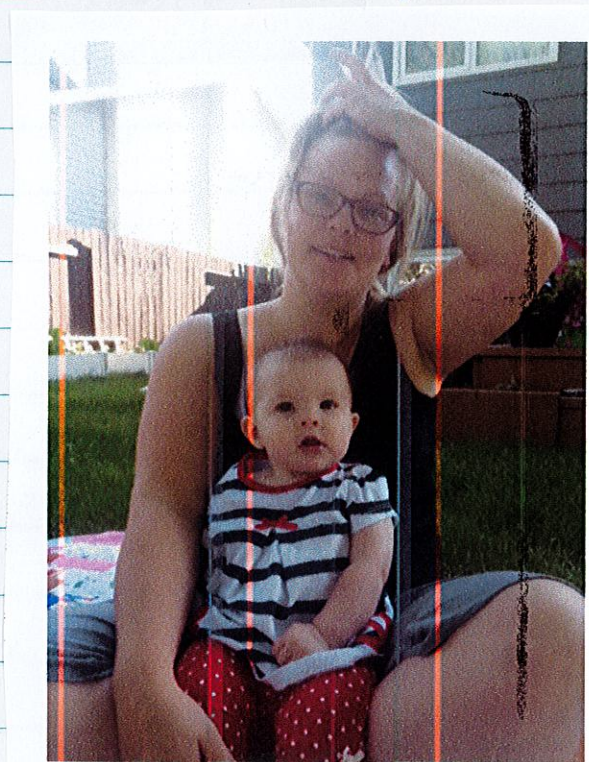


(Aug. 11) This is my favourite. Because it's my mom.
